“Just being able to go from city to city with four lanes is obviously going to provide much better transportation. It will not only provide a faster transportation route for our residents, but also for our public safety officers in emergency situations.” said Preet Didbal, Mayor of Yuba City, at the groundbreaking celebration.

The new bridge will connect 5th Street in Marysville to Bridge Street in Yuba City and create a new 2nd Street Bridge in Yuba City. The project will include realigning and widening of the lanes on the 5th Street bridge, installing three new traffic signals, and adding two additional through lanes on the bridge across Feather River.

The project will also include new ramps, relocation of existing utilities, improvements to adjacent pedestrian access, bicycle trails, levee access, removal and replacement of trees in floodways, retaining walls and concrete barriers, earthwork, paving and landscaping.



Construction began January 2018 and is estimated to be completed in the spring of 2020.

Starting January 29 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. through February 2nd and again on February 5 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. through February 7, 2018, there will be lane closures and traffic control on the 5th Street Bridge for tree removal necessary to construct the new improvements.
